9 Day Program (Option A): July 31, Aug 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10

6 Day Program (Option B): July 31, Aug 1, 2, 3, 6, 7

3 Day Program (Option C): Aug 8, 9, 10

Class Participation: All students aged 2+ (must be 2 years of age at beginning of camp and have approval by their teacher)

- Medium of instruction: English Only
- This camp is open to SP students only.

Number of Students: All classes have a minimum of 10 students. Bunny, Rabbit, Bluebird, Hiyoko and Ahiru classes, have a maximum of 16 students per class. Kangaroo, Giraffe, Koala and Panda classes, have a maximum of 20 students per class. Because of the limited number of seats available, seats will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Fees must be paid at the time of registration in order to secure a seat.

Tuition: 1,200 baht per day.

Bus Fee: 200 baht per day for 2-way 100 baht per day for 1-way

Child seat for Bunny & Rabbit classes (flat rate) = 3 or 6 days: 100 baht, 9 days: 200 baht

Enrollment: All applications must be submitted through the school office. You may not send the application through your child's bag or the bus. The camp bus schedule will be sent through ClassDojo for Inter Students and uploaded on the Japanese Section's website on July 24th.

Payment: By Cash at School Office only.

Enrollment Period: June 25th - July 6th.

Other Conditions:

- Students must choose from Option A, B or C.
- Should the school cancel a class, on their own accord, the school will refund the fee for that cancelled session.
- In case of cancellation due to unforeseen circumstances, there will be a 70% refund of the camp fee and bus service fees.
- No refund applicable except for the above mentioned. No refund will be given without the original receipt.

The Camp Teachers are International Section and ESL Department teachers. No Japanese Teachers are involved in Camp. The school nurse will be at school during this time.
